Motion by McVicker, Seconded by Vanness to approve the Agenda as presented. All ayes. Motion carried.

Motion by Vanness, Seconded by McVicker to approve the Board Minutes and Drainage Minutes dated 5/24/21. All ayes. Motion carried.

Public Comment & Board Committee Reports: McVicker attended Juvenile Detention Center Board while Nolte attended Access.

Jay Waddingham, County Engineer met with the Board and gave an update on his department. Olive Avenue should be finished this week. Crews are working on Spruce Ave near Highway 3. He has also met with the Sheffield mayor regarding the timeline of replacing the Olive Ave bridge.

Motion by Vanness, Seconded by McVicker to approve an application to perform work within Franklin County Highway Right-Of-Way for Chris Uhlenhopp to construct a culvert & fill ditch at 1373 Beeds Lake Drive. All ayes. Motion carried.

Jody Bardole, Dispatch Director, met with the board to provide an update on her department. She is now fully staffed and working through the kinks of new software.
