NOVEMBER 22ND, 2021**

The Board of Supervisors met at 8:30AM on Monday, November 22nd 2021, at the Franklin County Courthouse with Board members Nolte, McVicker, & Vanness in attendance.

Chairman Nolte led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Motion by Vanness, Seconded by McVicker to approve the Agenda as presented. All ayes. Motion carried.

Motion by Vanness, Seconded by McVicker to approve the Board Minutes dated 11/15/2021 as presented. All ayes. Motion Carried.

There was discussion as to whether or not the county would provide financial support of a project by Dumont Telephone for expanding fiber optic service in Franklin County. Motion by Vanness, Seconded by McVicker that the Franklin County Board of Supervisors does support Dumont Telephone Co in their expansion of fiber optic internet in the Eastern part of Franklin County and would provide such letter if needed.

All ayes. Motion carried.

There was discussion regarding county buildings and current and future needs by county departments.

Jay Waddingham, County Engineer, met with the Board and gave an update on his department.

Motion by Vanness, Seconded by McVicker to approve the closure of Mallard Avenue Between 40th & 50th Street as of 9:00AM on 11/15/21 for Tile Crossing. All ayes. Motion carried.

Motion by McVicker, Seconded by Vanness to approve the closure of Oakland Drive Between Finch Ave. and 45th Street as of 8:00AM on 11/17/21 for Tile Crossing. All ayes. Motion carried.

Russel Wood, CICS CEO, met with the Board to provide an update on his department.

Toni Wilkinson, Recorder, provided an update to the board on her department.

Roy Arends, representing the City of Alexander, met with the Board to request a tax certificate abatement on 302 Harriman Street. There was discussion regarding the assessments on it which includes

special assessments by the city, drainage assessments, and the property taxes. The city will need to abate their special assessments first and then contact the county to proceed.

Public Comment & Board Committee Reports: Vanness attended NICAO and FCDA. McVicker attended Central Iowa Juvenile Detention. Nolte attended Access. There was discussion regarding parking at the CRC building. No action was taken.
