Public Notice is hereby given to the qualified voters of the Iowa Falls Community School District in the counties of Hardin & Franklin, Iowa, that a Special Election for approving a PPEL (Physical Plant & Equipment Property Tax) Levy will be held on September 14, 2021. The Bradford Community Center will be the only polling location that will be open with polls in Franklin County. The polls for the said election will

be open from seven o'clock a.m (7:00a.m) until eight o'clock p.m. (8:00p.m.) for the purpose of voting on the following questions:

The Public Measure on the ballot is printed in full below:

IDENTIFICATION: Voters are required to provide an approved form of identification at the polling place before they may receive and cast a ballot. Voters who are not pre-registered or who have changed precincts are required to provide proof of identity and residency. Any voter who cannot show ID may have their identity attested to by another regis-

tered voter in the precinct who has proper ID. Starting January 1, 2019, all voters will be required to present an approved form of identification. For additional information about voter identification visit <https://sos.iowa.gov/voterid> or phone (641)-456-5622.

PUBLIC MEASURE A

Shall the Board of Directors of the Iowa Falls Community School District, in the Counties of Hardin and Franklin, State of Iowa, for any purpose currently or hereafter statutorily authorized, those purposes including the following: purchasing and improving grounds; constructing schoolhouses or buildings and opening roads to schoolhouses or buildings; purchasing of buildings; purchase, lease or lease-purchase of technology and equipment; paying debts contracted for the erection or construction of schoolhouses or buildings, not including interest on bonds; procuring or acquisition of libraries; repairing, remodeling, reconstructing, improving, or expanding the schoolhouses or buildings and additions to existing schoolhouses; expenditures for energy conservation including payments made pursuant to a guarantee furnished by a school district entering into a financing agreement for energy conservation measures; renting facilities under Chapter 28E; purchasing transportation equipment for transporting students; lease purchase option agreements for school buildings; purchasing equipment for recreational purposes; purchasing equipment authorized by law; or for any purpose or purposes now or hereafter authorized by law, be authorized for a period of ten (10) years, to levy annually, a voter-approved physical plant and equipment property tax not to exceed sixty seven cents (\$0.67) per One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000) of the assessed valuation of the taxable property within the school district commencing with the levy for collection in the fiscal year ending June 30, 2023, or each year thereafter?
