ORDINANCE NO. 144

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF SHEFFIELD, IOWA, BY AMENDING PROVISIONS PERTAINING TO ALTERNATE SIDE PARKING

BE IT ENACTED by the City Council of the City of Sheffield, Iowa:

SECTION 1. SECTION MODIFIED. Section 69.13 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Sheffield, Iowa, is repealed and the following adopted in lieu thereof:

69.13 ALTERNATE SIDE PARKING.

The provisions of this section prohibit the parking of vehicles or unattended vehicles on certain designated streets or parts of streets and shall apply when alternate side parking is in effect.

Provisions. Alternate side parking shall be in effect from December 1st through March 31st on Oakwood Drive and Crescent Drive. Odd-numbered side of the street on odd-numbered calendar days. The provisions of this change in procedure prohibit parking on parts of streets so designated on December 1st of each year to be stated in the announcement and such notice shall constitute notice to the general public.

Parking Prohibited Under Certain Conditions. After the times specified in the declaration of alternate side parking, it shall be unlawful for any person to obstruct the orderly removal of snow from the City's streets by parking or otherwise leaving unattended any vehicle in violation of said provisions.

A. For purposes of this section, parking shall be prohibited on the odd-numbered side of the street after 8:00 p.m. if the following day is an even-numbered day. Likewise, parking shall be prohibited on the even-numbered side of the street after 8:00 p.m. if the following day is an odd-numbered day.

Posting. The provisions of this section shall be in full force and effect when signs are posted on designated streets. "Alternate side parking is in effect December 1st through March 31st."

Termination of Alternate Side Parking. The termination of alternate side parking shall be effective immediately upon announcement. When alternate side parking is terminated, it shall then be lawful to park on those streets in accordance with the regular parking provisions of the City Code.

Penalty. If a notice of fine for a parking violation has been given by placing the original or copy thereof in plain sight on the windshield of the vehicle, and the fine is not paid as prescribed in such notice and as established by City Code, the City shall cause such violation to be filed against the registered owner thereof who shall be responsible for said violation. It shall be a misdemeanor for any person to permit or allow a motor vehicle to be parked in violation of the provisions of this Code. The penalty for each violation shall be \$25.00.

SECTION 2. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE.

If any section, provision, or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any section, provision, or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION 3. WHEN EFFECTIVE.

This ordinance shall be in effect from and after its final passage, approval, and publication as provided by law.
