WEST FORK COMMUNITY SCHOOL DISTRICT BOARD MINUTES

OFFICIAL PROCEEDINGS – SPECIAL MEETING – MAY 17, 2021 – UNAPPROVED

The West Fork Board of Education met a special meeting in the Superintendent's Office in Rockwell. The meeting was called to order at 12:00 PM by Board President, Grant Petersen (via Zoom). Board members present: Jeff Tudor, Mary Schlichting, Erin Suntken (via Zoom) and Roger Witte. Also present were Superintendent Mike Kruger, Elementary Principal Ashley Flatebo and West Fork Board Secretary Lacey Pueggel.

Visitors: Dick Fridley (via Zoom), Susan VanLaere (via Zoom), Shelley Sheppard (via Zoom)

Witte made a motion to approve the Agenda; seconded by Schlichting. Motion carried 5-0.

New Business:

Tudor moved to approve the Graduation Class of 2021 pending the completion of all required classes/work; seconded by Schlichting. Motion carried 5-0.

Other Business:

After discussion, Tudor moved to continue wearing Masks until the end of the school year; seconded by Suntken. Motion carried 4-1. Ayes: Petersen, Tudor, Suntken, Schlichting. Nays: Witte.

Witte moved to approve the following projects for summer completion, West Entrance at Rockwell (\$60,000), Restroom projects at Rockwell (\$149,000), work will be completed by Kingland; Replace and Upgrade door key fob and lock systems at both campuses work will be completed by Tech Zone (\$23,563); seconded by Schlichting. Motion carried 5-0.

Schlichting moved to have Iowa Drainage start the gravel parking lot north of the school; seconded by Tudor. Motion carried 5-0.

Tudor shared information about Cerro Gordo County Public Health's Lead Hazard program and grant funding. Brochures will be available to families.
